Key Responsibilities - Chapter

- Raise adequate funds in accordance with the chapter's budget and other financial goals, including an annual personal financial gift, making the American Red Cross one of your top-3 organizations for your annual personal giving
- Provide approval to the Regional Chapter's strategic and financial plans in alignment with national plans and regional strategies, ensuring local needs for Red Cross services are met
- Build chapter capacity for service delivery through the effective involvement and engagement of volunteers and partners
- Build the presence, awareness and support of American Red Cross services throughout the chapter jurisdiction
- Lead in building relationships (corporate, political, partners, etc.), representing the chapter locally and advancing the chapter within the community
- Work in partnership with the Service Area Executive in the hiring, evaluation/performance management, compensation and retention of the Regional Chapter Executive
- With the Chapter Executive, develop annual budgets that are in alignment with regional strategies and national goals
- Exercise fiduciary responsibilities, including budget oversight and good stewardship of locally held assets
- Ensure that the chapter is in compliance with Corporate Policies and Regulations and meets all performance standards
- Meet the basic obligation of board membership by regularly attending board/committee meetings, reviewing and questioning reports, fundraising and participating in planning processes
- Build leadership volunteer involvement

Key Responsibilities – Regional Grouping	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure that the Regional Chapter Executive develops regional strategies that align with and support the national Strategic Plan • Provide approval to the Community Chapter’s strategic, service delivery and financial plans • Help to build relationships (political, partners, etc.), that are representing the region • Build the presence of the American Red Cross across the region • Support fundraising with regional donors to build fiscal capacity within the regional grouping • Ensure that Community Chapters are in compliance with Corporate Policies and Regulations and meet established performance standards • Work effectively with their Regional Chapter, other Community Chapters and ARC Biomed units within their grouping to build regional efficiencies and performance. • Exercise fiduciary responsibilities, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Upon recommendation of the Regional Chapter Executive, approval of a consolidated regional budget consisting of all chapter budgets within the grouping ○ Consolidated budget oversight ○ Annual review of Community Chapter audits
Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Knowledge of and influence in community served by chapter • Willingness to support Red Cross Mission through fundraising, building partnerships, building visibility and/or building service delivery capacity • Expertise in an area of interest that can support Red Cross services • Ability to participate regularly in Board/Committee meetings • Leadership skills, including planning, monitoring and evaluating chapter’s programs and services, and public speaking
Continuing Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Orientation to American Red Cross • Board Orientation • Continuing education in governance and fundraising • Continuing Education in areas of interest (e.g. disaster, health and safety, human resources and volunteerism)
Term of Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Board members are elected to a three-year term; after a review of the board member's performance and of the chapter and board needs, the board member may be re-elected for a consecutive three year term.
Personal Development Opportunities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Opportunity to serve the community as a valued member of an organization that saves lives and educates people • Red Cross training, conferences, seminars, national convention • Beyond-the-chapter opportunities with Service Area Councils, Subject Matter Expert pools, national task forces and committees
