
Staff Health: Deploying a Healthy Workforce DSSSS204A, 09/06

Description	This PowerPoint-driven training experience describes the role and responsibilities of the Chapter Health Reviewer and guides the participants through the application of hardship codes related to the deployment of employees and volunteers to disaster relief operations.
Purpose	This training provides instruction that enables the Chapter Health Reviewer to complete the process of deploying a healthy workforce to a disaster relief operation.
Learning Objectives	After taking this course participants should be able to; <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Describe the role and responsibilities of the Chapter Health Reviewer• Review and apply Hardship Codes to the Health Status Record (HSR)• Develop and implement a confidential system for handling the Health Status Record• Utilize the Physical Capacity Grid• Utilize the Medical Guidelines• Complete a Health Status Record Review Summary Sheet• Explain the process for an Americans with Disabilities Act accommodation• Explain the role of the Chapter Health Reviewer in the pre-deployment phase
Audience	Chapter Health Reviewers (Registered Nurses and Medical Doctors) who perform Health Status Record Reviews.
Prerequisites	There are no prerequisites for this training.
Length	The course is comprised of one PowerPoint module, and takes approximately 60 minutes to complete.
Scheduling	This course can either be self-study or instructor led. Self-study participants can refer questions about the course and procedures therein to the Service Area Health Consultant. Instructor-led courses are scheduled and coordinated by the Service Area Health Consultant.
